Offers for the new show season Verden auction in April

Verden. The auction time for the Verden Auction in April begins directly after Easter. 48 dressage and 15 show jumping talents will be available for inspection and trying out from April 12 to 22. There will be offers for top sport as well as partners for ambitious amateurs of all disciplines. The auction of the riding horses will take place online. From April 16, bids can be placed on personal favourites, the final bid-up begins on April 22 at 2 pm CET.

Shortly before the riding horse collection moved into their boxes at the Niedersachsenhalle, the hero mentioned in the title of the auction brochure, FRH Davinia la Douce, took a brilliant sixth place at the World Cup Final in Omaha/USA with US-American Anna Buffini. The Balkenhol family bought Don Frederico/A Jungle Prince daughter bred by Robert Kühn, Hagen, as a four-year-old at the Verden auction. Anabel Balkenhol carefully trained her and brought the mare into international sport before Anna Buffini took over the reins in November 2020.

The four-year-old De Laura by Don Nobless/Ampere (breeder and exhibitor: Jochen Meyer, Allwörden) opens the collection with the head number 1. She comes from a successful breeding and sporting dam line that can be built on: The stallion Weltmeyer also goes back to the foundation mare Lorando. The jumping collection opens with the head number 4, and this mare, born in 2017, combines the very best jumping bloodlines. After Double V by Diamant de Plaisir/Cornet Obolensky (breeder and exhibitor: Hendrik Schäfer, Köchingen) gave birth to a filly by Clear Heart in 2021, she now devotes herself to sport. The dam line of Sabalota also includes the
